


Hansa Past and Present

Merchant Hansa

- Emergence of the merchant Hansa in the 12th Century:
 > traders from the North Sea and the Baltic Sea
- 1143: The founding of the Hanseatic city of Lübeck allows the merchants access to the trade with Northern Russia and western European countries (access to the Baltic Sea)
 - > trade with e.g. grain, wood (Northern Russia)
 - > trade with e.g. clothes and wine (western Europe)

From the Merchant Hansa to the Hanseatic League (12th-15th Century)

- There is no exact date when the Merchant Hansa became the Hanseatic League
- 13th Century: -Hometowns represent merchants in trade policy questions
- 15th Century: over 70 cities in the Hanseatic League
 - over 100 cities connected with the Hanseatic League



The Hanseatic League today

- Today there are 181 cities from many countries in the Hanseatic League
- Work:
 - > organization of the Hansa Days
 - representation of the Hansa idea
